Those of you who work in Obedience will know Sarah and some of you may remember the inspiring Sheltie Camp several years ago at which Sarah and her mother Barbara were the trainers.

Sarah has been competing in Obedience since 1989, and has qualified five dogs for Ticket, three Groenendaels and two Collies, with two of the Groens becoming Obedience Champions. She has also competed as part of the winning England World Cup team in 2009.

She also judges up to and including Championship 'C' and currently trains eight Ticket handlers (4 with Bcs, 2 with Goldies, 1 with a Parson Jack Russel and 1 with a Groenendael) as well as several Shelties working at different levels. She says "I love training the other breeds as well as the Collies and I think it helps that I have trained both up to Ticket level as they are very different in their attitudes."

Training will cover all classes and will start 9.00 a.m. and will last until 5.00 p.m. with a break for lunch. There will also be short coffee breaks during the morning and afternoon. Tea and coffee will be provided but please bring a packed lunch with you.
